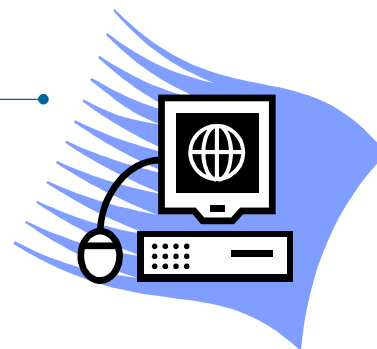

Welcome to another edition of the Sands Computer Group newsletter, and a warm welcome to our many new subscribers. I trust you will enjoy this learning experience.

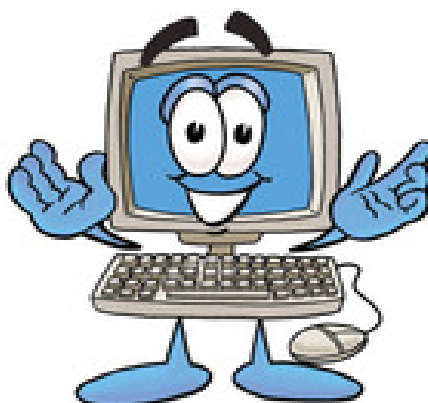
Our April meeting was well attended with four of the eleven people not having attended a previous session. I'm aware a few people were unable to attend due to other commitments.

The definition of Skype in Wikipedia says;

Skype is a software application that allows users to make voice calls and chats over the internet.

Calls to other users within the Skype service are free, while calls to both traditional landline telephones and mobile phones can be made for a fee using a debit based user account system. These calls are normally at a lower cost. In 2010 Skype had 663 million registered users.

Other features of Skype include instant messaging, file transfer and video conferencing.

If you really want to know what's inside your computer, then this is the program for you.

It provides a comprehensive profile of pretty well everything that's on your computer.

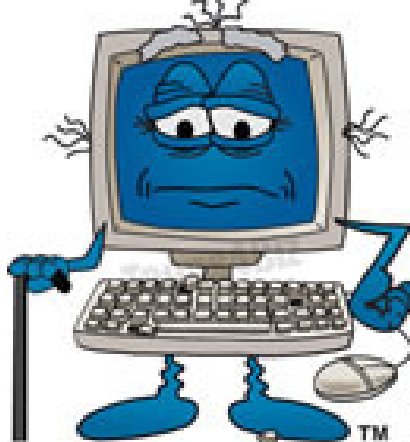
There are two versions of the program. One is downloadable onto your computer, the portable version can be downloaded onto a USB drive (stick).

When you click on generate the program scans your computer and provides a detailed report listing all the programs on your computer, manufacturer, isp name/address, serial numbers, part numbers, etc

MY EXPERIENCE

I downloaded the program onto a USB drive and then ran the program. In all there was a 20 page report, and while some information was mysterious to me, I will have a close look at it to determine what programs I can delete. It's definitely a good reference report.

It's easily done, and unless you have a backup, what can you do. Firstly look in the recycle bin. If it's there you can restore it. However if it's not in the recycle bin where is it and how do you find it?

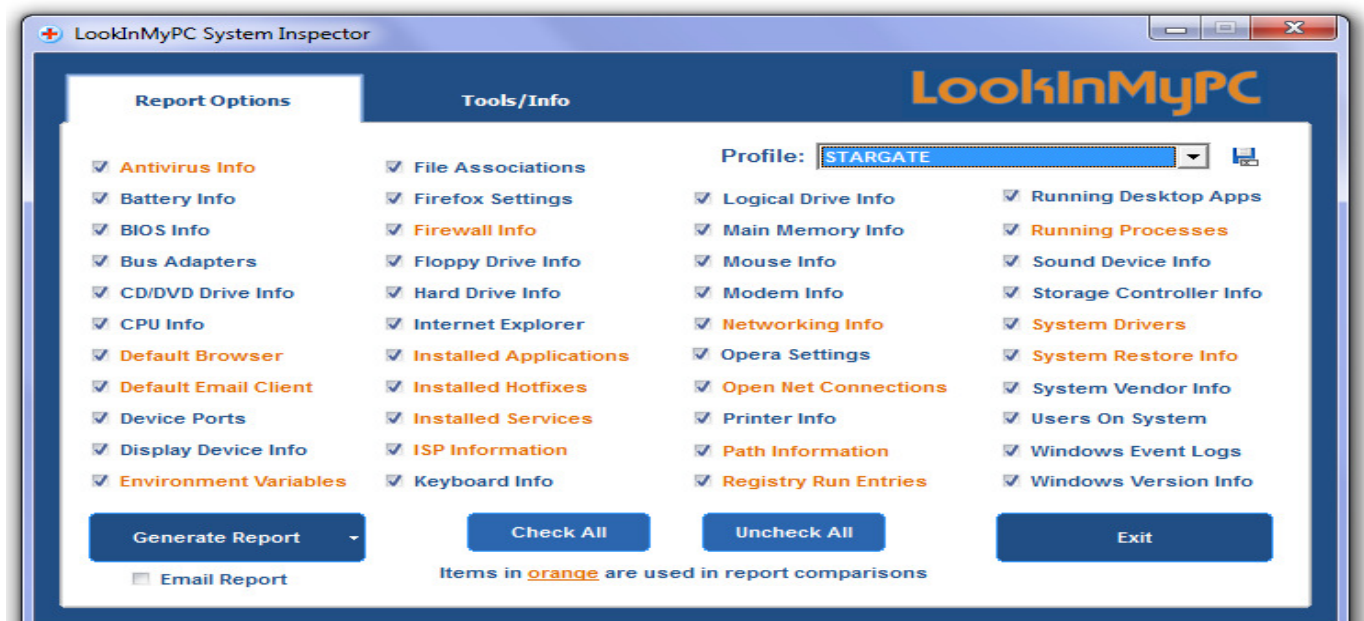
Recuva may be the answer to recovering your lost doc/photo. It's a free program, downloadable from the above address, and is used to recover deleted files.

INTERNET EXPLORER 9

This program has been stripped down like Google chrome and firefox. It's reported to be one of the fastest browsers, and over 20 million people have downloaded it.

Available to Vista and Windows 7 users, it comes in your Microsoft updates. So if you do not want to download it, be careful not to click it. MY EXPERIENCE

I downloaded it recently and haven't had any problems. It takes a little getting used to as the search box and address box are the same.



CHROME 11

This new version of Google's Web Browser is now available. It supports text to speech in supported web pages, and is designed for people who have difficulty using keyboards.

The user clicks on the microphone icon before speaking into their mic, and Chrome 11 then converts it to text and pastes it into the field. There are only a limited number of websites you can use this with at this time, but this will change.

SCREENCAST.COM

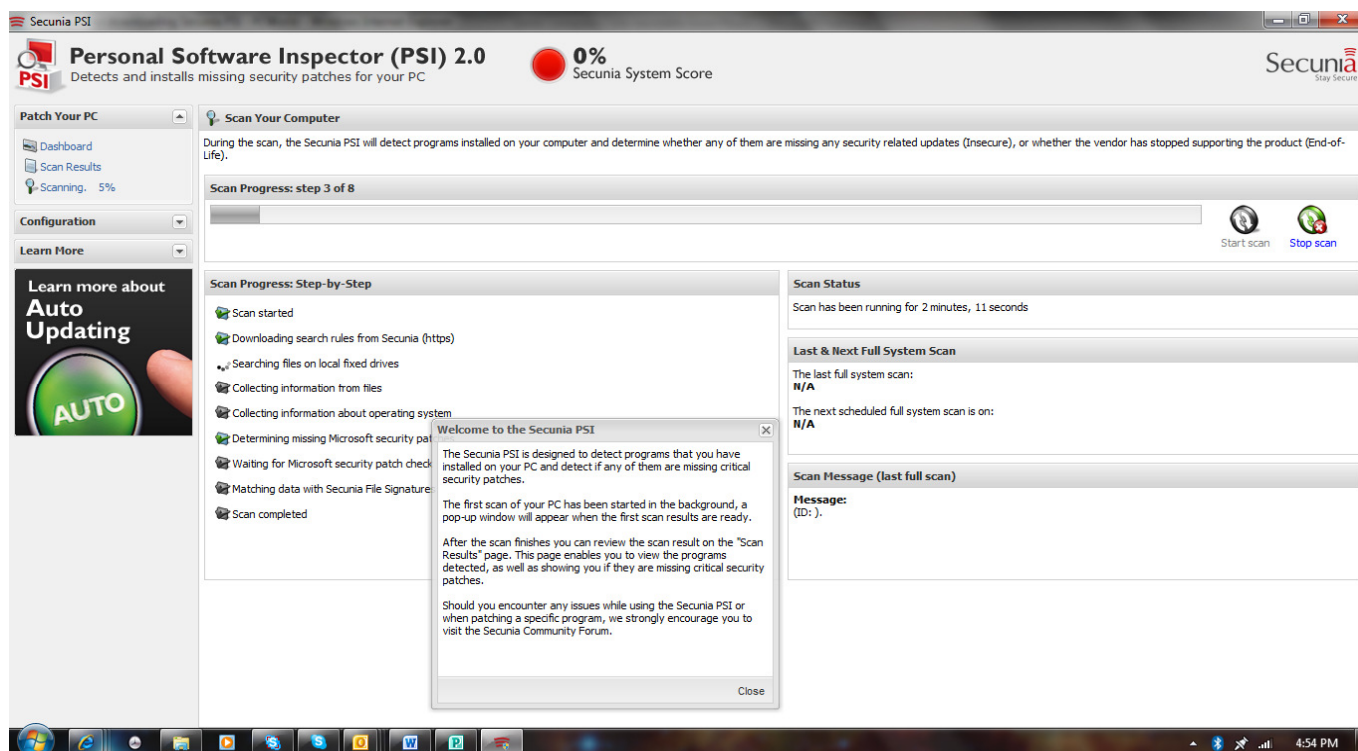

I thought twice about downloading this program because there are many programs which highlight problems on your computer, however after downloading and running the program, it showed my computer was only 90% secure. A number of programs were displayed as being out of date or needing patches, and had an "instal solution" address to download the solution.
