New Emoji coming this year



Watch out for this one if you use Microsoft Office 365

Phishing attacks aimed at the users of Microsoft 365 claim the recipient must renew their Microsoft 365 subscription. Abnormal Security advise there are two phishing campaigns, both impersonate actual notices from Microsoft. One campaign involves sending an email out advising that Office 365 is now Microsoft 365 and tells the user to renew by a certain date. It has a link to renew your subscription wanting your name, address and credit card details. The second campaign tells users their Microsoft 365 subscription has already expired and to renew now at the link (in the email). Both campaigns steal your details.

Beware TikTok - Apple Users

The Beta version of iOS14, Apple's new operating system will send alerts to users when an app tries to copy clipboard information. TikTok has been mentioned in the media as an app that is using this technique, however it isn't the only app doing this. LinkedIn has advised it will stop the practice. When the iOS14 beta version is released to the public shortly more apps are likely to be identified carrying out this sort of behaviour. AccuWeather, AliExpress, Call of Duty Mobile, Google News, Overstock, and Patreon are all apps identified.

Apple releases iOS13.6

New features in this update include—improved support for downloading and installing system updates, Apple news + Audio content (professionally narrated audio stories from the Apple News team) and car key feature. A new option in the software update > automatic updates section has two toggles. You can choose to automatically download iOS updates and to install updates overnight. This update also includes bug fixes. There's a caveat, some features may not be available in all regions.

Also released macOS 10.15.6, tvOS 13.4.8, watchOS 6.2.8 and audios 13.4.8 for homePod.

Google and Battery Drain

Google Chrome is known to be a resource hog on mobile devices like laptops and is linked to battery drain. So its good news to hear that Chrome version 86 is testing a new feature that limits Javascript timer wakeups for background websites to just once a minute. This will have the effect of extending battery life by just under two hours. Apple's Safari already uses this technique.

Editor: I continue to see devices which have anywhere up to 20 tabs open, especially on tablets and smartphones. Hence your battery drains. So don't forget to close the tabs when you have finished viewing the website.



Emails

Its been a while since I'd had a phishing email and then two in two weeks. A timely

reminder not to be complacent when dealing with your emails.

Both emails displayed the name of a friend in my contact list. One had a link hinting that I click on it, and the other requesting I purchase an item. When I looked closely at the email addresses they were not the ones in my contact list. The content looked suspicious.

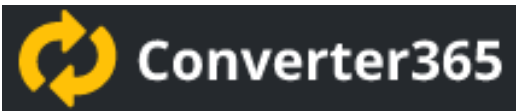

There are times when you have to convert a file but don't have a file converter installed. An example, you have a music video and want to convert it to MP3.

Converter365 is a **free online converter** which converts over 1000 different formats. Easy to use. Simply drag your file and drop it into the upload box. The file must be less than 200MB and is deleted thirty minutes after conversion.

Microsoft Edge—Updated version 84.0.522.40

New features include;

Improved site list download times for internet Explorer mode.

Users can now sign-into the browser when running as administrator on Windows 10

Online purchase improvement. You can add nicknames to saved debit or credit cards. You can distinguish and differentiate your credit cards when making online purchases.

Collections improvements:

A note capability is added. You can add a note or comment to an item in a collection.

Change the background color of notes in collections. Use color coding to help organise information and increase productivity.

Noticeable performance improvements that let you export your collections to Excel in less time than in previous versions of Microsoft Edge.

PDF improvements

Read Aloud PDF lets users listen to PDF content while doing other tasks.

PDF file editing is improved. Save an edit made to a PDF back to the file instead of having to save each time you edit.

Microsoft Edge now enables Translation in the Immersive reader. When a user opens the Immersive Reader view they get the option to translate the page to their desired language.

Notepad/Paint/Wordpad Windows 10

Updating to Windows 10 version 2004 seems to automatically uninstall them. Microsoft has classified these apps as optional and available in the Microsoft Store. However some users with 2004 installed have reported they have been unable to download the apps from the store and receive a message that the apps are already installed when they are not.

Stop website Notifications in Chrome

Do you get tired of seeing notifications when you visit websites? Its no longer just one or two websites, more and more are pushing notifications, all wanting your permission to you allow or deny the request before you can continue. Chrome's browser allows you to block website notification prompts. To do this *Left click the three vertical dots* top right hand corner > Left click *Settings* > Left click *Site settings* > notifications. You can stop sites asking to send notifications or allow them to ask. There are a range of actions under Block and Allow which give you control over what a website has access to and can do. These include location, camera, microphone, images, popups, Ads, sound, USB devices, motion sensors, to name a few.

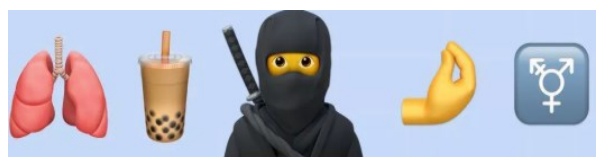

“Lorem ipsum dolor sit amet, consectetur adipiscing elit, sed do eiusmod tempor incididunt ut labore et dolore magna aliqua. Ut enim ad minim veniam, quis nostrud exercitation ullamco laboris nisi ut aliquip ex ea commodo consequat. Duis aute irure dolor in reprehenderit in voluptate velit esse cillum dolore eu fugiat nulla pariatur. Excepteur sint occaecat cupidatat non proident, sunt in culpa qui officia deserunt mollit anim id est laborum.”

I've seen this phrase from time to time and deleted it without considering what it meant.

The phrase is used in placeholder graphics, text bodies (ie in Word) and website pages. It's actually gibberish but it has an origin and a purpose. Designed to resemble Latin, it's a made up phrase used by typographers to fill blank spaces and draw viewers' eyes towards a website's layout. In the 1960's typeface Letraset sheets included it. In the 1990's computing software integrated it in publishing software. Its believed to date back to the 1500s and is a mis translated or reinterpreted by a printer who began using the phrase in templates for type-setting text.
